#### **Global News**

U.S. stocks rallied to close out the trading week on Friday as the S&P 500 set a closing record for the third time in five days after an upbeat U.S. jobs report and data on Chinese manufacturing eased concerns about slowing global growth, said a Reuters report. The Dow Jones Industrial Average rose 300.86 points to 27,347.09, the S&P 500 gained 29.36 points to 3,066.92, and the Nasdaq Composite added 94.04 points to 8,386.40. Asian shares rose to 14-week highs as growing optimism over U.S.-China trade talks and upbeat U.S. job data boosted global investors' appetite for riskier assets. The United States and China both said on Friday that they had made progress in talks aimed at defusing their protracted 16-month-long trade war, and U.S. officials said a deal could be signed this month, said a Reuters report.
